Moving House - Checklist

Removals

Make provisional enquiries from removal firms that belong to the British Association of Removers. Ask about the level of their insurance cover. Confirm once your Solicitor tells you the contacts are exchanged and your moving date is certain.

Most people move on a Friday but other days of the week may be easier.

Check your own home insurance to make sure you are covered from the day you move to your new home

If you are renting a property don't forget to notify your landlord of your moving date; there may be a clause in the lease/tenancy agreement about notice to be given

Services

Contact the utility providers to let them know when you are moving out and ask them to provide apportioned accounts for settlement prior to leaving the property. Contact utility providers for the property you are moving to.
